I am requesting funding for the **City of Industry Anaheim-Puente Road Over San Jose Creek Bridge Project** in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **City of Industry**, located at **15625 Mayor Dave Way, City of Industry, CA 91744**. The funding would be used for **repair of the Anaheim-Puente Bridge in Industry, CA, which is currently in poor condition and at risk of severe structural damage or collapse in the event of a natural disaster. This project will widen the bridge and will target known and documented safety problems by seismically retrofitting the bridge to prevent potential fatalities and serious injuries. These improvements will substantially improve the safety conditions for all drivers using the bridge to access the nearby businesses, railyard, and utility facilities.** The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because **it addresses safety concerns, reduces traffic congestion and related emissions, and improves the efficiency of freight movement.**

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by **23 USC 133**.
