I am requesting funding for **the Sandburg Middle School Cooling System Efficiency Project** in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is **Glendora Unified School District**, located at **500 N. Loraine Avenue, Glendora, CA 91741**. The funding would be used to **replace the outdated chiller system at Sandburg Middle School to ensure reliable temperature control and energy-efficient operation of the school's primary instructional facilities. The current system is beyond its useful life and has become increasingly unreliable during extreme heat events, creating unsafe classroom conditions and interrupting student learning. This project will modernize critical public infrastructure, improve energy efficiency, protect student health, and ensure uninterrupted educational access for the surrounding community.** The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because **it will modernize critical infrastructure, ensure safe and consistent indoor learning conditions, improve student health, and reduce long-term energy costs.**
